

DEED OF VARIATION TO THE FUNDING AGREEMENT

THIS DEED is made the 30th day of April 2026

BETWEEN

- 1) The Secretary of State for Education (the "**Secretary of State**"); and
- 2) INMAT, (the "**Company**") a charitable company incorporated in England and Wales with registered number 10427291, together, the "**Parties**".

INTRODUCTION

- A. The Parties entered into a funding agreement by deed of novation and variation dated 28 October 2025 (the "**Funding Agreement**") relating to the establishment, maintenance and funding of Rothwell Junior School in accordance with the Funding Agreement.
- B. The Parties now wish to vary and amend certain terms and conditions of the Funding Agreement in accordance with the terms of this Deed.
- C. This Deed is supplemental to the Funding Agreement.

1. INTERPRETATION

- 1.1 Words, expressions and interpretations used in this Deed shall, unless the context expressly requires otherwise, have the meaning given to them in, and shall be interpreted in accordance with, the Funding Agreement.

2. VARIATION OF THE FUNDING AGREEMENT

- 2.1 The Parties agree that with effect from the date of this Deed the Funding Agreement shall be amended as follows:
 - 2.1.1 The Capacity Number on the Summary Sheet shall be deleted and replaced with "480".
 - 2.1.2 Clause 2.B shall be deleted and replaced with
"The planned capacity of the Academy is 480 and the age range is 7-11. For the avoidance of doubt, notwithstanding that an individual applicant's age might be outside the specified age range of the Academy, the Academy is not prevented from considering an application made by the child's Parent(s) in order to comply with the relevant paragraph of the Schools Admissions Code ('Admission of children outside their normal age group'), to request that the child be admitted to the school outside of the child's normal age group. Where such a request is agreed, the child should be educated in an existing year group. The Academy will be an all ability inclusive mixed sex school."
- 2.2 Except as varied by this Deed, the Funding Agreement shall remain in full force and effect.
