

DEED OF VARIATION TO THE FUNDING AGREEMENT

THIS DEED is made the day of 26th August 2026

BETWEEN

- 1) The Secretary of State for Education (the "**Secretary of State**"); and
- 2) INMAT, (the "**Company**") a charitable company incorporated in England and Wales with registered number 10427291, together, the "**Parties**".

INTRODUCTION

- A. The Parties entered into a funding agreement dated on or about 29 November 2018 (the "**Funding Agreement**") relating to the establishment, maintenance and funding of Little Harrowden Community Primary in accordance with the Funding Agreement.
- B. The Parties now wish to vary and amend certain terms and conditions of the Funding Agreement in accordance with the terms of this Deed.
- C. This Deed is supplemental to the Funding Agreement.

1. INTERPRETATION

- 1.1 Words, expressions and interpretations used in this Deed shall, unless the context expressly requires otherwise, have the meaning given to them in, and shall be interpreted in accordance with, the Funding Agreement.

2. VARIATION OF THE FUNDING AGREEMENT

- 2.1 The Parties agree that with effect from 1 September 2026 the Funding Agreement shall be amended as follows:

2.1.1 The Age range on the Summary Sheet shall be deleted and replaced with "3-11".

2.1.2 The Capacity Number on the Summary Sheet shall be deleted and replaced with "210, plus a nursery of 8 places".

2.1.3 A new defined term, "*Funded Hours*" shall be inserted at clause 1.C and defined as "*means the current applicable government funded entitlement to free childcare*".

2.1.4 Clause 2.B shall be deleted and replaced with

"The planned capacity of the Academy is 210, plus a nursery of 8 places, and the age range is 3-11. The Academy will be an all ability inclusive school."

2.1.5 A new clause 2.E.1 shall be inserted as follows:

"Clause 2.16 of the Master Agreement does not prevent the Academy

Trust charging fees for nursery provisions outside the Funded Hours."

2.1.6 A new clause 3.I.1 shall be inserted as follows:

"For the avoidance of doubt, the pupil number count for the purposes of determining GAG excludes nursery provision pupils. Clauses 3.A-3.I must be read with this exclusion in mind."

2.2 Except as varied by this Deed, the Funding Agreement shall remain in full force and effect.

3. Governing law and jurisdiction

3.1 This Deed, and any disputes or claims arising out of or in connection with it, its subject matter or formation (including non-contractual disputes or claims), shall be governed by and construed in accordance with English law.

3.2 The parties irrevocably agree that the English courts have exclusive jurisdiction to settle any dispute or claim that arises out of or in connection with this Deed or its subject matter or formation (including non-contractual disputes or claims).

4. Counterparts

4.1 This Deed may be executed in any number of counterparts and by the parties to it on separate counterparts, each of which when so executed and delivered shall be an original, but all the counterparts shall together constitute one and the same instrument.
